

SUTTON RACQUET CLUB RULES

- 1) **Only residents of Sutton Towers and Sutton Place may join Sutton Racquet Club. Residents of Sutton Towers or Sutton Place as well as the Racquet Club Staff may sponsor non-residents for a 2010 seasonal guest pass at Sutton Racquet Club**
- 2) **If you are a resident of Sutton Towers or Sutton Place, you cannot play as a guest. You must join the Club.**
- 3) **Annual Sutton Racquet Club memberships and seasonal guest passes cannot be extended beyond the current season (April 2010 – March 2011), nor can payments be refunded.**
- 4) **Sutton Racquet Club memberships and seasonal guest passes cannot be transferred or sold.**
- 5) **Guest fees must be paid prior to play. If not, Sutton Racquet Club reserves the right to deny you and your guest(s) access to the courts. If the racquet club staff is not present, you must drop your guest fee through the mail slot.**
- 6) **When using the courts all players must wear proper tennis attire (shirts and pants). In addition, regulation tennis shoes must be worn – non-marking soles.**
- 7) **No pets are allowed in or around the Club (including tied to the fence).**
- 8) **Non-playing children must be supervised in the enclosure at all times, and must be kept off the courts. So must baby carriages, strollers, etc.**
- 9) **No bikes, big wheels, hockey play, roller blades, skateboards, etc...are permitted on the tennis courts or tennis court enclosure.**
- 10) **The Club is not responsible for any items damaged, lost or stolen while members, seasonal guests or guests are using the facilities. Belongings are not to be left at the Club overnight.**
- 11) **Damage to Club property will be paid by any member who willfully or negligently causes such damage, and any such amounts will be charged to the member's or seasonal guest's account. Members and seasonal guests are responsible for willful or negligent damage caused by their dependent children and guests.**

- 12) **Past and current fees must be paid in full before a membership or seasonal guest pass can be activated.**
- 13) **Use of the facilities and the services of the staff are at your own risk!**

SUTTON RACQUET CLUB RESERVATION RULES

- 1) **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS: A staff member will be available to assist you with your reservation weekends only during the off season (April, May, September & October). Reservations may be made up to seven days in advance of the day of play in person or by calling (202) 966-6428. You can also send an e-mail at suttonracquetclub@gmail.com to reserve your time.**

During peak season, a staff member will be available between the hours 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily, to take reservations. Please give your name, phone number and your partner's name(s) and whether they are a member, seasonal guest or a guest. If staff is temporarily unavailable during this period, please leave a message and your reservation will be scheduled in the order received.

- 2) **A member or a seasonal guest may hold only one hour of court time reservation at a time. Only after play may a member or a seasonal guest make a later reservation.**
- 3) **Members and seasonal guests may reserve one hour for singles play during prime time (Mon. – Fri. 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.) For example, members may not reserve a court 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. for singles play. Your second hour will automatically be given to the next member or lesson participant as needed.**
- 4) **There is a \$15.00 guest fee for each guest. All guest fees must be paid prior to playing. The guest fee applies at all times of the day or night. When the pro shop is unattended your guest fee(s) payment can be placed through the mail slot on the pro shop door. Failure to make this payment will result in suspension of court privileges until the guest fee(s) are paid.**
- 5) **CANCELLATION: Reserved court time must be canceled at least three hours in advance of play. However, in consideration of other members wishing to play, cancellations should be made with as much advance notice as possible.**
- 6) **Regarding “prime time” (weekdays 4:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.) anyone who fails to cancel a reservation will receive an oral warning. Once a third warning is received, reservation privileges will be suspended for two weeks. Any further**

violation will result in reservation privileges suspended for the remainder of the season.

- 7) Unlimited Guest Fee: A member who has purchased the optional guest fee of \$150.00 with their membership must understand that this guest pass is unlimited in occurrences, not in guests at one time. Therefore, there will be \$15.00 charge for each additional guest.**
